#### **Harvington Hall**

Harvington Hall is a Tudor house like no other, with the largest collection of Elizabethan wall paintings and 7 remaining priest holes, which is more than any other house in England. Step back in time and allow yourself to be immersed with the sights, sounds and smells of an Elizabethan Christmas. With engaging characters to meet you as explore the beautiful Harvington Hall.

#### **Greyfriars** (National Trust)

Greyfriars is a late 15th-century timberframed house in the heart of Worcester, saved from demolition and brought back to life by siblings Elsie and Matley Moore. Wander through the beautiful timberframed house and explore a traditional Tudor Christmas and festive pastimes with your family and friends.

## The Firs, Elgar's Birthplace (National Trust)

The birthplace of Sir Edward Elgar is most definitely home to a "Land of Hope and Glory". The Firs opens in December with Christmas trees, twinkling lights and natural decorations. For two weekends it will be open to all to enjoy the festive environment, then the last two weekends there will be a special visitor from the North Pole.

#### Hanbury Hall (National Trust)

Hanbury Hall is a William and Mary-style country house, set in beautiful formal gardens and rolling parkland in the heart of Worcestershire. Get a blast from the past as you explore the house dressed for the Christmas inspired by 1970s & 1980s.

## Witley Court & Gardens (English Heritage)

Step back in time to a bygone age of great wealth when the house played host to royal parties. Enjoy the beautiful gardens, lake and woodland walks. A perfect place to enjoy Worcestershire's green countryside over the festive period.

#### **Croome Court (National Trust)**

Croome Court, the once home of the Earl of Coventry and the centrepiece of Croome's 'Capability' Brown designed parkland. Enjoy immersive projection experience seeing Croome at Twilight, as well as tailored wreath making workshops.

Discover one of Worcester's most atmospheric historic buildings. Once the Royalist Headquarters during the decisive Battle of Worcester in 1651, The Commandery invites you to explore centuries of history brought to life through its striking architecture and tranquil gardens.

A family run breakfast and brunch restaurant located near Worcester, one of the most popular brunch spots in the county.


